What is a cookie?

A cookie is a small file that can be placed on your device that allows Code Siren to recognize and remember you. It is sent to your browser and stored on your computer's hard drive, tablet, or mobile device. When you visit Code Siren sites, we may collect information from you automatically through cookies or similar technology.

How do we use cookies?

Other organizations collect user information on our sites through cookies, tags, and pixels. Tags and pixels, also known as web beacons, are similar to cookies but are collected through embedded images. Using cookies and other technology allows other organizations to help us analyze how our site is used and measure the number of visitors. Cookies used by Code Siren, LLC are referred to as "first-party cookies," and those used by our partners are "third-party cookies." Because of how cookies work, our website cannot access third-party cookies, nor can other organizations access the data in the cookies we use on our website. There are more details about both in the following sections.

What types of cookies do we use?

We use three types of cookies, which we describe in this section.

- **Essential:** Cookies that are essential to provide you with the requested services. If you set your browser to block these cookies, these functions and services will not work. In particular, we won't be able to save your cookie preferences.
- **Performance:** Cookies that measure how often you visit our sites and how you use them. We use this information to better understand how our users engage with our website and improve our sites to give users a better experience. For example, we collect information about the most frequently visited pages and types of users. We also use third-party cookies to help with performance. For example, the Analytics cookie gives us information such as your journey between pages and whether you have downloaded anything (details of how to opt out of it are below).

- **Functionality:** Cookies that recognize you and remember your preferences or settings when you return to our site so that we can provide you with a more personalized experience. A mix of first-party and third-party cookies is used.

How to manage cookies:

Using the steps here, you can manage cookies and disable sharing data with partners for advertising. Sometimes, you can turn off advertising cookies on a cookie-by-cookie basis, and we give the most common examples below.
